The following information must be provided to the Fire Prevention Bureau before any permit is issued.

- 1. Name of the person, group, or organization sponsoring the production.
- 2. Date and time of day of the production.
- 3. Exact location of the production.
- 4. Name of the person in charge of firing the pyrotechnics (i.e., the pyrotechnic operator).
- 5. Number, names, and ages of all assistants who are to be present.
- 6. Confirmation of state and federal licenses held by the operator or assistant(s). All personal listed for the show will be checked for valid OSFM licenses.
- 7. Copy of insurance Liability \$1,000,000, Property damage \$500,000 and \$1,000.00 bond due at time of permit submission.
- 8. Inventory of pyrotechnic devices and materials to be used.
- 9. Diagram of the grounds or facilities where the production is to be held that shows the point at which the pyrotechnic devices are to be fired, the fallout radius for each pyrotechnic device used in the performance, and the lines behind which the audience is to be restrained.
